

ALCATRAZ TRIP

Alcatraz is a former federal prison. It is a 25-acre island located just 1-1/4 miles from San Francisco's Fisherman's Wharf and is best known as the infamous and notorious former federal prison-home to the likes of "Machine Gun" Kelley, Al Capone and Robert "The Birdman" Stroud. The trip departs from Fisherman's Wharf and is about a ten minute ferry ride. SEAT (Sustainable Easy Access Transport) is available for wheelchair users and others who are unable to walk up the quarter mile, 12% grade hill.

Departure times are 9:30 am, 10:15 am, 11:15 am, 11:45 am, 12:15 pm, Return times are 12:15 pm, 12:45pm, 1:15pm, 1:45pm, 2:15 pm. Boarding time is 30 minutes prior to departure.

To pick up your tickets on the day of your trip, you must bring a current photo ID and the credit card used to make the purchase. Please dress in layers. Wear comfortable walking shoes. Only bottled water is available at Alcatraz.

Tickets can only be ordered on-line and must be purchased at least 72 hours in advance. All sales are final no refunds. www.AlcatrazTickets.com or call toll Free 1-888-814-2305 for more information before purchasing.
